Good Health at an Affordable Cost Can All Governments afford Universal Health Coverage?

This event will focus on the adequacy and affordability of universal health coverage (UHC) as a key driver to ensure healthy lives for all people of all ages. Three main

aspects will be highlighted:

- Update the global discussion on how UHC can be measured to ensure universal access to good-quality essential health services <u>including financial risk protection</u>, so that people stay healthy and no one is pushed into poverty or kept in poverty due to catastrophic health expenditure.
- Demonstrate ongoing health financing reform, which supports the argument that <u>UHC is affordable even in low-/middle-</u> <u>income countries</u>, while strong political will is crucial to drive the reform.



 Discuss the concept of an <u>essential package of promotive, preventive, curative, and</u> <u>rehabilitative health services</u>, which can address nationally set health priorities based on domestic disease burdens, such as maternal and child health, sexual and reproductive health, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, and non-communicable diseases
